

INFORMATION FOR AHUA 2018 DELEGATES – a brief overview

Here's a quick summary of key information about AHUA Spring Conference 2018. More information can be found on the AHUA <u>website</u>.

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Venue

The Conference will take place in the Martin Harris Centre, on the University of Manchester campus. [Address: Martin Harris Centre, The University of Manchester, Oxford Road, Manchester, M13 9PL] Information on travel to the Martin Harris Centre appears on the website. Pedestrian access to the venue is off Oxford Road, down Coupland Street where the green Museum entrance sign is. Past the Museum, you will find the Martin Harris Centre on your right hand side.

Coat rail and luggage room are available if required.

Accommodation

Accommodation has been booked for all delegates in the Holiday Inn Manchester – City Centre, 25 Aytoun St, Manchester M1 3AE. Check in is at 2pm – luggage can be stored at the hotel for those arriving on Monday morning prior to being able to access the room, and check out is at 11am. Conference Registration

On arrival, you will receive a name badge and a delegate pack containing event materials.

For security reasons, you should wear your delegate badge at all times within the conference venue.

Internet Access

There is free Wi-Fi for delegates in the main venue. Password information will be supplied at registration.

Mobile Phones and Cameras

Mobile phones MUST be switched off or in silent mode in the conference rooms at all times.

Please do not use flash photography during presentations, as this can be distracting to speakers and fellow audience members.

Refreshments and Lunch

Coffee, tea and lunch will be provided in the morning and afternoon breaks in the Martin Harris marquee.

Conference Dinner

There will be a conference dinner taking place on each night of the conference in:

The <u>Manchester Museum</u> on Monday 9th April (drinks reception at 7:15pm followed by dinner at 7:45pm, dress code: smart casual)

The Whitworth Hall on Tuesday 10th April (drinks reception at 7:15pm followed by dinner at 8:15pm, dress code: business)

Travel

Manchester is served by an international airport, two mainline rail stations and a network of motorways.

If arriving at **Manchester Piccadilly rail station** and going **straight to the hotel**, please follow the instructions <u>here</u>. The hotel is a 3 minute walk from the station

If you are arriving at **Manchester Piccadilly** and going **directly to the conference venue**, the 147 bus is convenient and direct and runs Monday to Friday daytime (last bus 18:15). The alternatives are a taxi (around £5-£7), a 20-minute walk, or a shorter walk to the frequent bus route which serves Oxford Road.

If you arrive at **Oxford Road station**, there are numerous buses which travel up and down this road, stopping very close to the Martin Harris Centre.

If you travel by air, **Manchester International Airport** is approximately 10 miles from the Campus. A taxi from the airport will cost around £25. Alternatively, make use of the rail link between the Airport and Piccadilly railway station, which runs every 15 minutes and a single ticket costs around £4. The station is adjacent to terminal two and is clearly signposted within all terminals. The number 43 bus also runs from the Airport every 10 minutes during the day and every 30 minutes after 7.30pm and throughout the night. A single journey costs around £3.

A coach has been arranged to take you from the hotel to the conference venue each morning and evening. The coach schedule can be found in the accommodation section.

If you need to use a taxi, the number for Mantax is 0161 230 3333 or Streetcars can be reached on 0161 228 7878.

Car Parking

The closest car park to the hotel is <u>NCP Chatham Street</u> (M1 3AY). Your ticket can be validated by the hotel for a cheaper rate.
