The following posts are available for election to the AHUA Executive Committee:

Deputy Chair, Devolved Regions (commencing 1 September 2020)
Nationally Elected Members (two posts, commencing 1 September 2020)

The period of office for these positions is three years.

Nominations

Members are invited to propose candidates for election on the following basis:

1. The **deadline** for nominations is Friday 31 July 2020 at 12 noon.

Nominations should include:

- a) A proposer who is a current AHUA member
- b) A seconder who is a current AHUA member
- c) Acceptance from the proposed candidate who is a current AHUA member

2. **Proposers** and **seconders** should send an email to the Executive Secretary or Administrative Assistant including their name and institution with the text:

"I hereby nominate / second (name of candidate) as a candidate for election as the Deputy Chair, Devolved Regions / Nationally Elected Member, of the AHUA."

3. Candidates should send an email to the Executive Secretary or Administrative Assistant including their name and institution with the text:

"I hereby agree to my nomination as a candidate for election as the Deputy Chair, Devolved Regions / Nationally Elected Member of AHUA."

Election process

1. Names of all candidates will be published by email w/c 3 August 2020.
2. If more than two nominations per role are received, an election will take place administered by ERS.
3. Only one vote per member institution will be permitted.
4. Voting will be by the single transferable vote method.
5. In the event of complications arising, the decision of the serving Chair of the Executive Committee will be accepted as binding and final.
