

AHUA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, NATIONALLY ELECTED MEMBER ROLE DESCRIPTION

Nationally Elected Members are appointed for a three year period, renewable for a second term.

The role comprises:

- attending four AHUA Executive meetings a year (two online and two in person);
- taking on a 'portfolio' in an area of the AHUA's interests, as appropriate. This could be a
 national policy area (eg immigration) or an area of work for the Association itself (eg
 communications or development). The Member would be expected to report on this area
 at Executive and Conference Business meetings;
- giving input to Executive Officers and the office on various national and operational issues between meetings.

After serving a second term, the member is eligible to rejoin the Executive Committee after an interval of 12 months.
