The deadline for nominations is **Monday 15 May 2023, 12 noon**

The following posts are available for election to the AHUA Executive Committee:

- Deputy Chair** (commencing 1 September 2023)
- Nationally Elected Members** (two posts, commencing 1 September 2023)

The period of office for these positions is three years.

Nominations

Candidates are invited to seek nomination on the following basis:

1. The **deadline** for nominations is Monday 15 May 2023 at 12 noon.

Nominations should include:

- a) A proposer who is a current AHUA member
- b) A seconder who is a current AHUA member
- c) Acceptance from the proposed candidate who is a current AHUA member

2. **Proposers** and **seconders** should send an email to the Executive Secretary or Administrative Assistant including their name and institution with the following text:

“I hereby nominate / second (name of candidate) as a candidate for election as the Deputy Chair (Devolved Regions) / a Nationally Elected Member, of the AHUA.”

3. **Candidates** should send an email to the Executive Secretary or Administrative Assistant including their name and institution with the following text:

“I hereby agree to my nomination as a candidate for election as Deputy Chair (Devolved Regions) / a Nationally Elected Member of AHUA.”

Election process

1. If more than two nominations per role are received, an election will take place administered by Civica Election Services.
2. Only one vote per member institution will be permitted.
3. Voting will be by the single transferable vote method.
4. In the event of complications arising, the decision of the serving Chair of the Executive Committee will be accepted as binding and final.
