Honorary Treasurer (commencing 1 September 2024) **Nationally Elected Member** (commencing 1 September 2024)

The term of office for these positions is three years.

Nominations

Candidates are invited to seek nomination on the following basis:

1. The **deadline** for nominations is Monday 27 May 2024 at 12 noon.

Nominations should include:

- a) A proposer who is a current AHUA member
- b) A seconder who is a current AHUA member
- c) Acceptance from the proposed candidate who is a current AHUA member
- Proposers and seconders should send an email to the Executive Secretary or Administrative Assistant including their name and institution with the following text:
 - "I hereby nominate / second (name of candidate) as a candidate for election as the Honorary Treasurer / a Nationally Elected Member, of the AHUA."
- Candidates should send an email to the Executive Secretary or Administrative Assistant including their name and institution with the following text:
 - "I hereby agree to my nomination as a candidate for election as Honorary Treasurer / a Nationally Elected Member of AHUA."

Election process

- 1. If more than two nominations per role are received, an election will take place administered by Civica Election Services.
- 2. Only one vote per member institution will be permitted.
- 3. Voting will be by the single transferable vote method.
- 4. In the event of complications arising, the decision of the serving Chair of the Executive Committee will be accepted as binding and final.
